Specific exclusions	ANR cannot fund clinical trials.  Subcontracting costs cannot exceed 50% of the requested funding per partner.  French industrial and commercial partners participating to this call should establish an agreement with a French CoEN, regardless of whether they apply for funding or not.  PhD scholarship are not eligible for funding in this call.
Allowable costs	<b>Minimum requested budget €15,000</b>
1. Direct Costs	For public entities salaries for tenured researchers cannot be included. PhD scholarships are not eligible costs for this call.  Consumables, animals, travel and subsistence are eligible according to the standard provisions of the ANR <i>règlement financier</i> .  Major items of equipment (above €11,400) are not permitted within the call.

Allowable costs	<b>Maximum €166K requested budget</b> (for the German partner/s) per project. Budget calculations should exclude VAT.

## Italian Ministry of Health (MoH), Italy

### Terms and conditions

- **Only Scientific Institutes for Research and Health Care (IRCCS) are eligible to apply.**
  - A simultaneous PI participation in different 2022 EU transnational call funded by the Ministry of Health is not allowed.
  - In order to expedite the eligibility check process, the MoH will grant an eligibility clearance to the applicant prior to the submission of the proposals. To this end, **it is mandatory that the applicant fills out and return to the MOH a pre-eligibility check form through IRCCS/ISS Scientific Directorate using WFR System-> ER communication code, before submitting their proposal to the Joint Call Secretariat: [www.salute.gov.it/imgs/C\\_17\\_pagineAree\\_444\\_1\\_listaFile\\_itemName\\_0\\_file.pdf](http://www.salute.gov.it/imgs/C_17_pagineAree_444_1_listaFile_itemName_0_file.pdf)**
- It is strongly recommended that the form, completed and duly signed, is returned **at least 10 working days before the proposal submission deadline.**
- Applicants will be sent a written notification of their eligibility status. Changes of acronym and budget provided in the pre-submission eligibility check are not allowed.

### Allowable costs

**Maximum €250K requested budget** (for the Italian partner/s) per project

#### 1. Direct Costs (staff)

1. Personnel (only temporary contracts/fellowships) - maximum 50% of the total requested funds;

#### 2. Direct Costs (Consumables)

2. Consumables (no limit);  
Animals (no limit);  
Travel costs and subsistence allowances associated with training activities only linked to the project (maximum 10% of the total requested funds);  
Dissemination of results (publications, meetings/workshops etc.) - maximum 1% of the total requested funds;  
Data handling and analysis (no limit)

Subcontracts are not allowed.

Transfer of money abroad is not allowed.

Equipment rent/leasing only - no limits

4. Indirect Costs	Overheads (maximum 10% of the total requested funds). Other indirect costs are not allowed.
Reporting requirements	Italian grant holders will be required to submit the related reports during the annual Ordinary Research (Ricerca Corrente) reporting procedure.
